MEDICATION SAFETY

- Keep visitors' purses, bags and coats out of reach, as they may contain medicine.
- Child-resistant packaging is not childproof. So put medicine away immediately after every use.
- Only use the dosing device that comes with the medicine



- Follow dosing instructions for all prescription and over-the-counter medications
- Make sure your child knows that medicine incorrectly can cause harm.
